The Australian Early Development Census (AEDC) provides a national measurement to monitor Australian children's development. The results can support communities to understand the local levels of developmental vulnerability and where that vulnerability exists within their community. The 2018 National Conference will focus on the evidence base that is being built in Australia about what works for children and families in the early years. Narrogin Primary School is the only school from the Wheatbelt Region represented. Tanya and David, will bring back valuable insights into ways the AEDC is being used to identify and respond to the needs of children and families, and new policy directions.

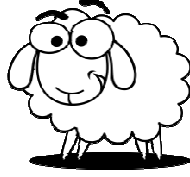
Flames Netball Club are seeking players interested in playing in the Set Tier of NetSetGO.
