#### ATTENDANCE

A reminder that a written or verbal reason for non-attendance must be given to the teacher or front office. It is only reasonable for a student to miss school if they are sick, or have a medical, educational or family appointment. Extended vacations can be approved by the Principal but a request in writing is necessary.
