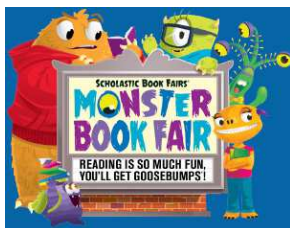
#### From the Principal

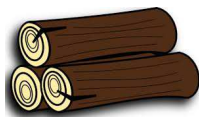
