WALK TO SCHOOL DAY

Now in its 17th year, National Walk Safely to School Day (WSTSD) is an annual event when all Primary School children will be encouraged to walk and commute safely to school. It is a Community Event seeking to promote Road Safety, Health, Public Transport and the Environment. The event will be held throughout Australia on Friday 20 May 2016.

The objectives of WSTSD are:

To encourage parents and carers to walk to school with primary school age children and reinforce safe pedestrian behaviour.

To promote the health benefits of walking and help create regular walking habits at an early age.

To ensure that children up to 10 years old hold an adult's hand when crossing the road.

To help children develop the vital road-crossing skills they will need as they become mature pedestrians.

To reduce the car dependency habits that are being created at an early age and which will be difficult to change as children become adults.

To promote the use of Public Transport.

To reduce the level of air pollution created by motor vehicles.

To reduce the level of traffic congestion.

Narrogin Primary School will be participating through having "Walking Buses" designed to guide children to school safely from a drop off point. Attached to the newsletter is a copy of the "Walking Buses" timetable and map, which will assist you to decide where to wait on Friday morning to 'catch' a bus. Parents, family and community members are also encouraged to join in by walking with us to school. Once at school, students who have participated will receive a small breakfast snack as well as listen to some Narrogin Police Officers talk about road safety, stranger danger and the role police can play in their safety. Kindy students will also be escorted safely back to the kindy premises, should they want to attend. Tea and coffee will be available for all participating parents and community members once at school.

Thanks to the P&C for supporting this event and to the school staff for assisting with the running of the "Walking Buses". We look forward to seeing you on the footpath on Friday morning!

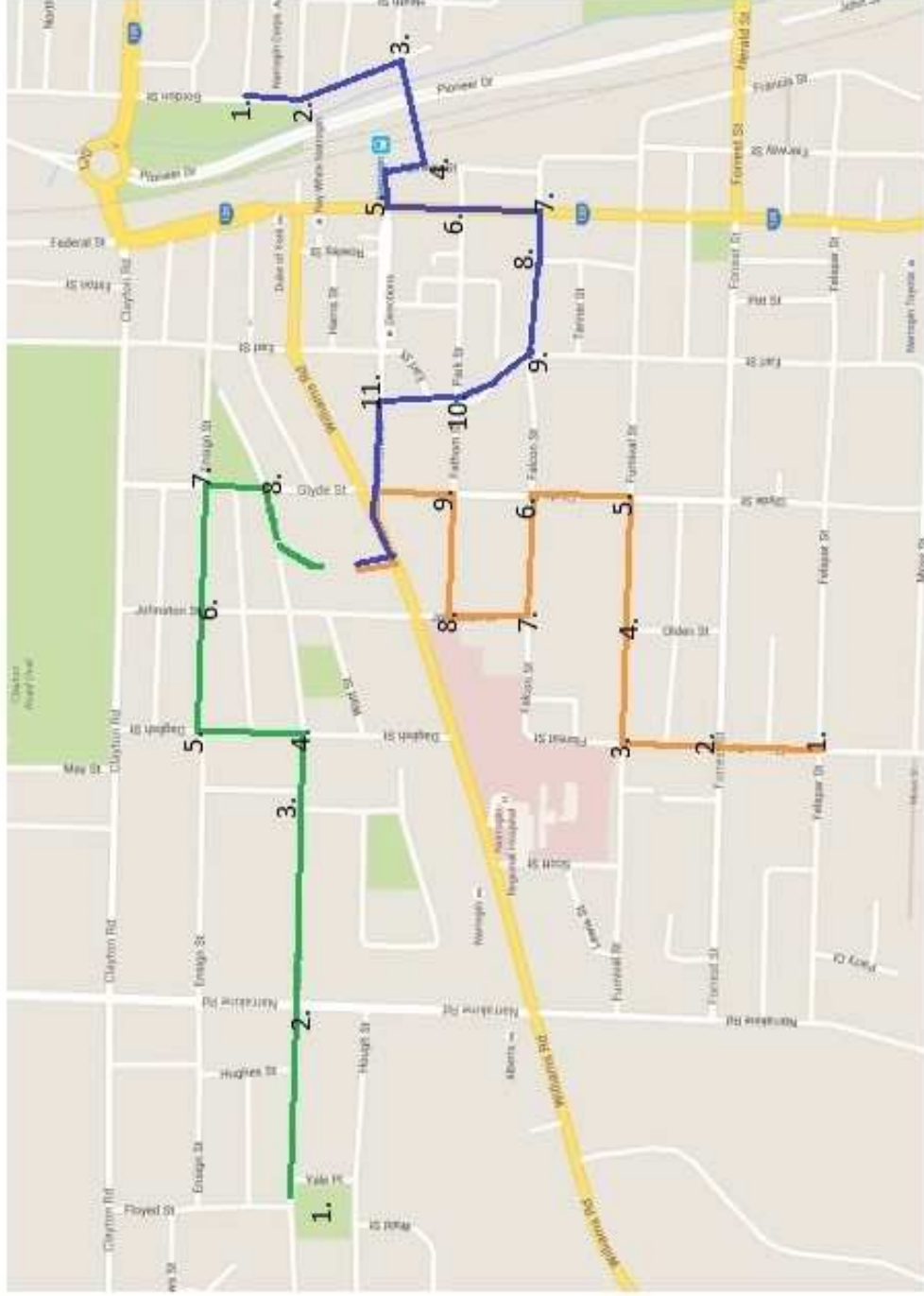
