### From the Principal

#### KISS AND DROP ZONE

As everyone is aware, the Kiss and Drop Zone is now in operation. The Town Council has erected new signage on Johnston Street detailing the parking restrictions for that area, please be aware penalties will now apply for not complying with these rules. School Board members will discuss a set of guidelines for using this area safely at tonight's meeting, and a pamphlet will be distributed to all school community members later this week. We strongly urge everyone to use this area with caution and be particularly mindful of pedestrians crossing Johnston Street.

#### EFFLUENT WATER TANK

The concrete effluent water tank situated in the Gardener's compound has been condemned and will be demolished in the coming weeks. Access to this immediate area will be restricted due to the nature of the work being undertaken. The replacement tank will be installed at the south eastern end of the school oval. Unfortunately, 3 mature trees needed to be removed to facilitate this, however a new tree planting program will be undertaken. The Narrogin and District Horticultural Society has kindly offered a donation of some funds to the school with which we will purchase some appropriate trees to plant in the area.

The Gardener's compound will also be relocated and the area where the concrete tank was situated will be levelled to extend the cricket pitch playing area.
