2017 KINDERGARTEN ENROLMENT DAY

There will be an 'Enrolment Day' for students beginning Kindy in 2017 on Friday 22 July at the Narrogin Primary School, Falcon Street Kindergarten from 12.30pm – 1.30pm. Students eligible for kindergarten in 2017 are those who turn four between July 1 2016 and June 30 2017. It is important to bring your child's birth certificate, immunisation record and any court orders that may be in place.



Eligible students will be enrolled provided there is classroom accommodation, an appropriate educational program can be provided and any specialised healthcare needs can be met. It is expected that once children are enrolled, they will attend Kindergarten on a regular basis. In 2017, students will be able to attend Kindergarten for fifteen hours per week.
