#### From the Principal

#### IN-TERM VACATIONS

Due to the impact on your child's learning, both Narrogin Primary School and the Department of Education strongly discourage in-term vacations. If you do decide to take your child out of school for a vacation, you are required to write to the school principal in advance, to outline the reasons for the vacation and seek approval. Otherwise your child's absence will be recorded as a unauthorised vacation.

#### EARLY CLOSE SUPERVISION

At present we have a number of children being supervised on Tuesdays during Early Close. There are a lot of students participating which means we are at capacity as far as numbers go. During these sessions, every student is expected to comply with the school's Behaviour Management Policy. We follow a similar process to the school's five step behaviour procedure:

Step 1: Verbal Warning

Step 2: Verbal Warning

Step 3: A period of time out from activities

Step 4: Student withdrawn for the remainder of the session. Admin will contact the parent/carer.

Severe Clause (verbal or physical abuse of staff or student, damage to property, intimidating behaviour) – immediate withdrawal of student and admin to contact parent/carer to collect their child.

Please Note: Repeated or severe inappropriate behaviours will result in a ban from after school care. Parents will be required to collect their child from school at 2.30pm each Tuesday.
