NAPLAN ONLINE TESTING

NAPLAN online is being introduced from 2018, with an aim for all schools to be administering NAPLAN online by 2020.

During this month, selected students in Years 3 and 5 will participate in a trial of the assessment platform, by undertaking two online readiness tests that include examples of the new NAPLAN online questions. Each test will take about 45 minutes to complete, these tests are TRIAL only and therefore will not be assessed. Participating in this trial is important as it will help us ensure we have adequate internet connectivity, and determine whether students have access to sufficient number of devices for NAPLAN Online testing.
