NATIONAL SCHOOLS OPINION SURVEY

It is a requirement that all schools distribute opinion surveys for students, staff and parents to complete. These surveys are typically distributed every 2 years. We are now entering into the data gathering period for 2016 surveys.

Our results from the last opinion surveys distributed in 2014 were heavily scrutinised in last year's DES school review. The school administration team also considered the responses from the 2014 surveys and, wherever practicable/relevant implemented measures to address the concerns that were highlighted in the survey results.

VI BARHAM AWARD

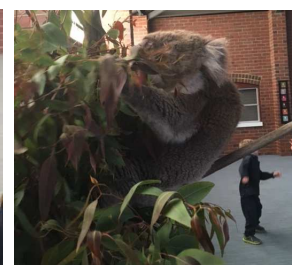
