INTERSCHOOL CARNIVAL

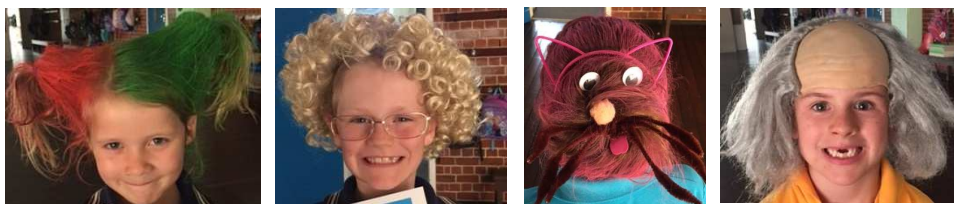
